LIVE STREAMING

Live streaming is showing a video of yourself or others in real time either privately or to an audience. Think Facebook Live, YouTube Live or even FaceTime when you video call another person.

ONLINE FRAUD

Fraud can take place online. Fraud is when someone tricks you into doing something to usually make a financial gain for themselves.

Fraud can involve:

- Fake competitions – ‘You have won an iPhone’
- Phishing – sending multiple fake emails to a number of people trying to trick them into giving you their personal details.
