Key Word	Definition
Physical features	The result of natural processes and events that create landforms e.g. waterfall
Human features	These have been made by people and include settlements, transport and the use made of the land
Monsoon	Meaning a season each year, there is a wet and dry one in India
Shanty settlement	A collection of poor quality housing, often lacking electricity, water and sewage
Interdependent	When countries work together and rely on others for help
Exports	Goods and services produced in one country sold to another country
Imports	Goods bought by a country that were produced in other countries
