

## The King's Academy: Pre-return Lateral Flow Test (Sept 2021)

All students are asked to take a lateral flow test (LFT) during the 24 hour period before returning to school after the summer break.

Year group	Return to school	LFT date
7, 12	Monday 6 Sept	Sunday 5 Sept 2021
8, 9, 10, 11, 13	Tuesday 7 Sept	Monday 6 Sept 2021

If a student is ill and cannot attend on their first scheduled day, then they should self-test during the 24 hours before the date on which they subsequently return.

If a student tests

- **Positive:** self-isolate – do not attend school – book a PCR test immediately, inform school.
- **Negative** (and no symptoms\* of Covid 19): attend school, with this declaration.

\*Symptoms (from the NHS website):

The main symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are:

- **a high temperature** – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- **a new, continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- **a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste** – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Most people with symptoms have at least 1 of these.
